How to prevent injuries



To prevent falls:

- Always face the cab when climbing in or out.
- Keep hold of handles to help you balance.
- Do not jump from the tractor cab.



To prevent collisions:

- Use lighting and safety markers on tractors.
- Be aware of passing vehicles on the road.
- Use signals when turning.



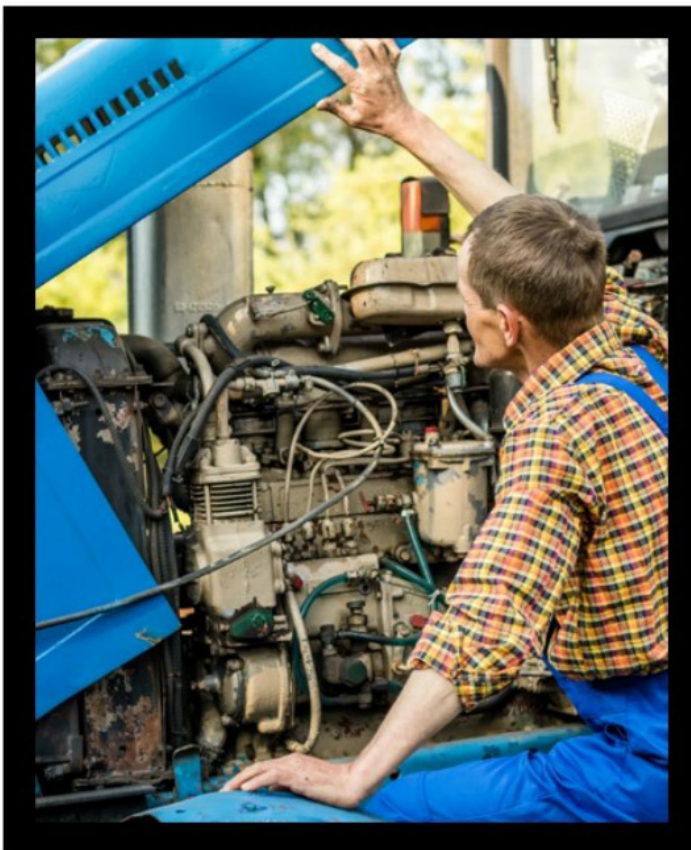
To prevent runovers:

- Keep visual contact with nearby workers during tractor operation.
- Take out of gear and set brake before exiting.



To prevent injuries from rollovers:

- Equip all tractors with Rollover Protective Structures (ROPS).
- Wear seatbelts when the tractor is in motion.



To prevent getting cut or caught:

- Keep long hair and loose clothing away from any moving parts of the equipment.
- Turn the engine off and put the tractor in park before making any repairs.
- Check that the hood is securely in place before making any repairs.
