

The GPCAH podcast, FarmSafe, is looking for brief recordings (1-2 minutes) from Ag Health and Safety students about why you are interested in agricultural health and safety and what kind of work you are doing.

What do we need? Short audio files (1-2 minutes) of you discussing your research or how you got interested in agricultural health and safety. Here are some questions to get you thinking. You certainly don't have to answer these questions; they are just prompts.

Interest in Ag H&S:

- How did you get involved with Ag Health and Safety?
- What background do you have that was useful to make the transition?
- When were you first confronted with health and safety issues on the farm?

Research

- What hazards are you addressing?
- Where do ag workers encounter this hazard on the farm?
- Why is this your focus?
- What injuries/illnesses do they contribute to? How common are they?
- What would you say to get a farmer interested in your work? To take preventive measures?

How to record?

- QuickTime (on a mac) has an "Audio" record function.
- Voice Recorder on PC
- Voice memos app on your iPhone
