# SAFELY EXTRACTIBLES STUCK VEHICLES GREATPLAN

Getting stuck is a common occurrence.
When it happens, stay calm & remain focused.

### Before starting extraction, walk around vehicle and then confirm:

- √ Tow vehicle is at least as heavy as the stuck vehicle
- ✓ Straps/chains & clevises are rated for the vehicle weight
- ✓ Safe connection is to a low point that is a structural member

✓ Where the Clear Zone is located

Before starting, check in with others or have another person assist you.

## KNOW YOUR A ZONES

## STUCK ZONE

Area surrounding the stuck equipment. The deeper a vehicle is stuck, the more force


you will need to extract it.

## **CLEAR ZONE**

Center for Agricultural Health

Safe area outside of danger zone.

Once the slack is pulled out of the strap/chain, everyone should be moved to the clear zone.



**TOW ZONE** 

Area surrounding the tow vehicle.
If possible, position the tow vehicle on higher, solid ground.

**DANGER ZONE** 

Area surrounding the stuck & tow vehicle.

Straps/chains can break causing flying debris that can strike something or someone.
