



GPCAH Pilot Projects

Request for proposals

GPCAH is funding up to 3 pilot projects (max \$30,000 direct costs) intended to promote innovative outreach and research efforts to prevent agricultural injury and illness. The pilot program supports both community-based organizations and academic researchers.

Projects must target agricultural injury and illness prevention to help improve safety and health among agricultural communities in the Midwest region. Applicants may propose a duration of no more than 18 months. We especially encourage pilot projects addressing work-related stress & mental health, equipment/tool safety, falls prevention, and chemical safety.
