# PREVENTING SLIPS, TRIPS & FALLS

*Reduce your risk of injuries by identifying hazards and following prevention tips.*

**Wear slip-resistant footwear with good tread.**



**Slow down on uneven terrain, steps, & wet surfaces.**



**Mark changes in height & use non-slip mats on wet surfaces.**



**Keep work areas clean & paths clear of debris.**

## COMMON RISK FACTORS:

- ① Working in livestock pens, barns, and silos
- ② Mounting and dismounting ladders, equipment, and machinery
- ③ Hazardous weather conditions
- ④ Uneven, slippery, or wet surfaces
- ⑤ Surface height and incline changes
- ⑥ Working in cluttered or dimly lit areas and buildings
